



President's Podium

In 2006, AANR celebrated its 75th anniversary. A lot was written about our organization's history and the progress that we have made.

Recently, I came across a 1981 year-end report from the American Sunbathing Association (the name of our organization at that time). It was interesting to see the changes that our organization has experienced in the last one-third of our history.

In 1981, AANR did little to promote membership. That was the job of the clubs. AANR only had to process the paperwork. Every member of a club was also a member of AANR. They had no choice. The contract with the clubs required that all of its members be members of the national association and one of its regions. In later years, the rules were changed and some clubs made AANR membership voluntary. In the past few months, however, we are seeing several clubs of all sizes committing to bringing all of their members into AANR. I thank them for their commitment.

Since 1981, AANR has nearly doubled its membership but this growth is not uniform in all sizes of clubs. Clubs with over 300 members have shown significant growth but clubs with less than 300 members produce about the same number of AANR members as they did 25 years ago.

The biggest change is in the Associate members, those AANR members who do not belong to a club. In 1981, only a few

members fit into this category. They were members who moved to an area where there was no club or whose club disbanded. More recently, many of our members joined AANR directly by phone or on the Web site. This group has grown by 10 times and now makes up 37 percent of our membership.

I've read that many not-for-profit organizations are experiencing declining membership. The Elks, Moose, Masons, etc. are not attracting members at the level they did years ago. There are many theories about the cause of this decline. It may be that the family structure has changed and "Dad's night out" is not as common as it once was. We are also told that this is a generational issue and that the younger adults are not "joiners" in the way that their parents were.

Why is it that AANR has doubled its membership with the most significant increase coming from non-club members? Again, there are many theories. Perhaps our Associate members are people who do not want to be tied to a particular club but find value in the 20 percent discount on gate fees when they visit our clubs. Perhaps they want to support AANR's government affairs efforts

to protect their right to visit nude beaches and hot springs. Perhaps they like to receive The Bulletin and use it to plan their next nude vacation.

A recent issue of Forbes magazine had a half page article describing AANR's marketing efforts to attract college age members. The article was accurate, but does this mean that AANR will lessen its efforts to attract more Baby Boomers who are the core of our membership? Of course not. The irony is that the piece that Forbes chose to write will be read primarily by Baby Boomers and the AANR phone number and Web site are prominent.

Reviewing how we have changed in 25 years exemplifies how much more diverse AANR membership has become. Are you a member of a large club, a smaller club, or no club? Does your club require AANR membership or is it voluntary? Each of you has a different perspective of what AANR membership means to you.

The makeup of our clubs has changed as well. They range from small groups of a few members with or without grounds to large upscale resorts. They include clubs who arrange cruises, beach advocate groups, and online dating services. Each provides a different benefit to its members.

In the next year we will be doing more surveys and other market analysis to give us more information on the needs of our members. One thing is very clear: We can't sit back and think that the world is as it was in 1981. Both our membership and clubs have changed. AANR will continue to tweak its marketing approach to recognize our diversity while adhering to our mission and promoting our brand. ☺

We are members of AANR and avid readers of *The Bulletin*. At one time, we heard that you were looking for articles, and now we have a reason to send you one.

My wife, Ann, and I recently stayed at a clothing-optional bed and breakfast place. We want to introduce others to this wonderful place—Cufra Cliffs Bed and Breakfast on Thetis Island. Thetis Island is a tiny tree-covered rural island off the east coast of Vancouver Island, Canada. It is quiet and beautiful with no town, gas stations, or shopping malls. If isolation is what you desire and wish to stay with people who care not what you wear or don't wear, Cufra Cliffs has a place for you.

We stayed in the private cabin on a west-facing 300-foot cliff overlooking an inlet with no houses in sight. We were served hot, oven fresh bread, homemade jams, and hot coffee for breakfast. A more enhanced breakfast is available. We enjoyed the hot tub that also provided a slightly different view but equally tranquil. In early September the daytime weather was 80+ degrees F. The weather rarely gets severely cold. Cufra Cliffs hosts only one group at a time, thus no conflict with other guests. The cabin has one room with a queen bed and a couch/bed in the living room and a kitchenette if you wish to cook. If not, the island has two restaurants, one with a liquor license.




avoid dangerous legislation that would possibly close some of our clubs and beaches here. I have first-hand knowledge of occasions when we could not get in to see various lawmakers because we were not in their districts, or worse, not even in their states. After an urgent call is placed to the INF-FNI headquarters, a message is sent to the necessary legislators, mentioning their 250,000 members, many of whom travel to the U.S. because they can visit nudist resorts and nude beaches. It is explained that these INF-FNI members would now be looking for other places to go if certain nega-

tive legislation would be enacted prohibiting nude recreation. Suddenly, doors would be open to us, and we would be invited in to discuss the AANR position on a certain bill and explain why our facilities and beaches should be exempt from certain legislation.

For those of you who have never attended an INF-FNI Congress, it is a wonderful gathering of nudist friends from all over the world. Approximately 29 countries attend, so, due to the many languages spoken, interpreters are needed. Earphones are scattered around for guests so they can hear what is being discussed. Many of our AANR people have been able to participate in this first-hand when the INF-FNI Congress is held stateside as it was in 2004 at Cypress Cove Nudist Resort and Spa in Kissimmee, Florida. The next INF-FNI Congress will be held in Brazil at Tambaba Beach in 2008. Why not plan now on attending? You already have your INF-FNI passport!

Editor's Note: At the World Congress in 2006, George Volak was elected First Vice President of INF. This is the highest office ever held by a member of our Association. George will oversee the operation of the INF office in Antwerp, Belgium. He'll be a "long-distance" executive director.

Barbara Hadley was elected by INF as the representative for non-European federations. Her election marks the first time that AANR has had two members in elected positions in the INF at the same time. Barbara's husband, Dean, is the INF representative appointed by AANR. ☺

Some Facts About INF-FNI

- The INF-FNI defends the interests of its members as well as those of non-organized, but practicing, naturists worldwide.

- It was founded in 1953, and is an organization under German law, with a registered office in Bonn, Denmark.

- Worldwide, it covers 29 countries with a national federation, as well as a number of countries where naturism is still in its infancy and where the INF-FNI works through correspondents.

- The INF-FNI strives for the official recognition of the "human right to nudity in a natural environment and in natural conditions."

- To advance the purpose of naturism, the INF-FNI holds a biennial World Congress.

- The INF-FNI furthermore coordinates the organization with a yearly World Naturism Day to promote nudist ideals and to attract interested persons to the club grounds.

- In a wider and integral sense, the INF-FNI watches over naturism, knowing that there can be no worldwide recognition of naturism without a solid nudist base. Hence the 1974 Adge, France's definition of what is Naturism, internationally ap-

proved and formulated, on the fundamentals of naturism: "Naturism is a way of life in harmony with nature, expressed through social nudity, linked to self-respect, tolerance of differing views together with respect of the environment."

- The INF-FNI takes the initiative, or supports national federation initiatives, for environmental protection purposes.

- The INF-FNI fosters the development of new nudist grounds, the foundation of federations as well as other promotion initiatives in states without a national federation, by administrative or representational means.

- The INF-FNI organizes contacts and exchanges between nations and federations, as well as offering legal assistance and arbitration services to its member organizations.

- The INF-FNI publishes brochures to boost international awareness of experience acquired in nudist undertakings, including the organization of nudist grounds, financing opportunities, sexual and commercial trends and hazards, as well as naturism as a movement in civilization.

- The INF-FNI organizes annual sports tournaments featuring typically nudist sports like swimming and pétanque.

- The federation has a library and archives in Baunatal/Kassel, Denmark; and Antwerp, Belgium, for historical and other research purposes.

- The INF-FNI answers questions about naturism asked by governments, officials, institutions, or individuals.

- The INF-FNI sells promotional items.
- The federation's secretariat is established in Antwerp, where the total document production is translated into the INF-FNI's three official languages (English, French, and German)

- The INF-FNI is led by two bodies elected by the appropriate World Congress: the seven-member Central Committee and the three-member Executive Committee, the members of which come from different countries and who meet regularly. Both committees deal with issues fundamental to naturism including acceptance, sports, youth, PR, finances, etc. Each committee member has a duty to care for the interests of naturism as a whole rather than represent his or her country of origin. ☺

Today, AANR's mission is to "Advocate nudity and nude recreation in appropriate settings, and educate and inform society of

the value and enjoyment of such..." The change of thought has followed our mission where we used to protect our rights, we now advocate. Can you see the difference? These changes in words and attitudes have lent to the astounding accomplishments we experienced in 2006. An increasing number of legislators, local officials, and members are relying on AANR to answer their questions when nude recreation is the topic at hand. It is a tribute to the AANR organization when we are beginning to be seen as the credible voice of reason when it comes to nude recreation.

With this shift in thinking, the tools we use must also evolve. For some years AANR has utilized StateNet (www.statenet.com) to monitor state legislative sessions and bills throughout all 50 states. This year AANR will be complementing our StateNet tool with a powerful software called Capwiz (www.capwiz.com). Capwiz XC is an innovative government relations research tool that helps organizations effectively communicate with state and federal elected officials by increasing advocacy participation from their members. The combination of these two tools will allow us to monitor legislation and set up an effective alert system to our AANR members and partners. Jim Corsentino, a long time AANR East GA advocate, has been instrumental in making this step a reality. Thanks for all your perseverance, Jimmy.

What does all of this mean to you? Simply, your AANR organization will have the up-to-date information on who your legislators are, including their staff. We now have a tool where we can network our volunteer members



While implementation is still in progress, we are convinced this will greatly add to our advantage to advocate for nude recreation. AANR Midwest Responds To Senate Bill

Ohio State Senate Bill 245 presents a prime example of bad law legislated in response to an unfortunate incident of flagrant, predatory public indecency in front of minor by a convicted and designated sexual predator. The legislation increases the level of punishment for mere nudity in the presence of a minor, especially if the accused has any prior conviction for public indecency, making no distinction between lewd conduct and benign nudity.

The bill was introduced in late December of 2005 and titled "Public Indecency." It subsequently passed the Senate Judiciary and Criminal Justice Committee at the end of March 2006 and was sent onto the House and was assigned to its Criminal Justice Committee. While remaining in play since then, the bill appeared destined to die in the lame duck session of the state legislature. AANR, AANR Midwest, and The Naturist Action



a matter of minutes he had received automated confirmation of receipt from several recipients, as well as an e-mailed confirmation of the message sent and a list of all who received it.

Ohio Senate Bill 245 passed out of committee without amendment and went onto the House floor where it also passed on December 14. However, the efforts mounted in this joint protest did not go unnoticed and will not go unrewarded. The sheer fact that twenty some constituents sat face to face with the committee members, and that reasonable and credible testimony was read into the record, will fare well should this law have cause to be challenged. This is a positive result. Special thanks are extended to all who participated in this impressive response to a critical situation on such short notice. ☺

Committee (NAC) received assurances from various legislators through our shared lobbyist that the bill would not pass, but would be given a sponsor's hearing as a courtesy to its originator. However, in a matter of a few days in early December the situation turned into a full court press toward passage before the end of the legislative session, only a few short weeks away. A final hearing on the bill was scheduled for December 12 before the House Criminal Justice Committee. We had only five days in which to marshal a response.

The unanticipated turn of events prompted a flurry of phone calls and e-mails between me, NAC Executive Director Bob Morton, AANR Executive Director Erich Schuttauf, AANR Government Affairs Coordinator Patricia Orner, and AANR Midwest VP and Government Affairs Chair Mark Hammond. NAC issued an Action Alert on December 7, and AANR issued a similar alert in the Trustee and Club Weekly Reports, both urging a response from our Ohio members.

With additional phone calls and e-mails to AANR Midwest board members and Ohio clubs, Mark Hammond and I were able to rally a dedicated team of Ohio volunteers that included both AANR and The Naturist Society members to attend the committee hearing. The AANR Midwest contingent included Directors Dan Garringer (Cedar

Trails), Don Phillips (Northcoast Naturists), and Bruce Rosander (Great Lakes SunSeekers). Also represented were club owners Fred and Jo Anne Roessler of Cedar Trails and Dave Weber from Paradise Gardens. The team spent a long day in the Ohio Statehouse in Columbus waiting for the hearing scheduled for 2 p.m., but delayed by an unrecused session until almost 7 p.m. We worked closely with Bob Morton and Bob Neinast (Ohio Coordinator), and with Andy Bowers, our shared lobbyist, to mount an impressive strategic presence and testimony for the public hearing. Morton, Neinast, and I presented vocal and printed testimony to the Committee. The entire team, numbering close to 20 and strategically placed throughout the hearing room audience, at one point stood in unison to make our collective presence known.

In addition to these efforts, AANR implemented through www.capwiz.com/aanr an alert allowing e-mails to be sent to every member of the House Criminal Justice Committee with just a few keyboard strokes and mouse clicks. An Ohio resident and I were the first AANR members to utilize this resource. The resident reported that this new dynamic grassroots tool was quite fast, very user friendly, and most impressive. Within

Esteemed Members of the Ohio House of Representatives and of this Committee:

Hello!

My name is Harvey Hanna. I am a resident of the State of Ohio.

I live and work in the City of Toledo. I am a registered and active voter in House District 48, served by Representative Edna Brown. Our neighboring House District 49 is served by Representative Jeanine Perry, a member of this Committee.

I am married, and I am a father and grandfather. My wife, Jean Holden-Hanna, and I have lived in the same house on Collingwood Boulevard in Toledo's Old West End for more than thirty years. Our newest next door neighbors are Toledo City Councilman Michael Ashford and his wife, Ruth.

I am and have been a public school teacher for almost thirty years. I am also an ordained minister and formerly a pastor in the Lutheran Church.

I am also honored to serve as the current President of the Midwest Region of the American Association for Nude Recreation. In this position, I speak for some 6800 members of our Midwest Region, of which a significant number reside in Ohio, and for some 44,000 members in our national Association.

Thus, as I speak, I do so not only for myself but for those whom I represent as well.

We stand opposed to Ohio Senate Bill 245, as it is presently written.

While we are entirely sympathetic to the particular circumstances that gave impetus to the formulation of Bill 245 and are in agreement with what we perceive as the intent of this legislation, we believe that the Bill, as written, makes for flawed and unwarranted law for the State of Ohio. It is for this reason that we oppose this Bill.

We ourselves embrace and endorse a policy of a zero tolerance of predatory exposure or behavior of any sort. In fact, many of the clubs in our Association conduct sexual offender/predator background checks on members and would be members in a routine manner. We do not believe that mere nudity, even in the presence of minors, constitutes any manner of public indecency or predatory behavior. Social nudism as advocated by our Association and as embraced by our members has historically been and will continue to be a family oriented practice that welcomes and includes children of all ages. We believe in the inherent and essential wholesomeness of all human bodies and in the naturalness of social nudism, and that the exposure it affords us benefits our physical, mental, and spiritual health. We want to pass these beliefs on to our children.

We believe that Senate Bill 245, as it is written, makes no attempt to distinguish lewd conduct and the practice of nudity in skinny dipping, in nude sunbathing, on nude or clothing optional beaches, the casual nudity of the Ohio boating community, and other such forms of nude recreation. The Bill makes no distinction or differentiation between such activities and dangerous sexually predatory acts. This lack of focus and differentiation in the Bill would make bad law for the State of Ohio.

Our beliefs and our concerns form the basis of our opposition to Senate Bill 245, as it is written. We request respectfully that the members of this Committee consider the bill unfavorably.

If the Committee remains committed to the intent of the Bill, and we do stand in agreement with the perceived purpose of punishing true sexual predators, then we would encourage the Committee to consider and adopt the Naturist Action Committee's proposed alternative language for Ohio Senate Bill 245. We think that this more carefully crafted alternative language would make of this legislation better and more acceptable law.

This is my and our position.



Why Fizzle When You Can Sizzle?

□ Open-minded nature leads to nude recreation adventure.

TAMPA, Fla.—Ask Angye Fox how she became a nudist and the short answer involves relocating to Florida a decade ago from her native Green Bay, Wisconsin.

The longer answer involves a spur-of-the-moment trip to Paradise Lakes Resort several years ago and an open-minded nature that has kept her exploring a wide range of business endeavors and entrepreneurial pursuits that include serving as a marketing consultant for two AANR clubs.

The 36-year-old single mother has reinvented herself several times, and not just professionally. She adopted the surname Fox after her second divorce, partly in tribute to the Fox River Valley area of Wisconsin where she grew up, and partly because her married names kept getting mispronounced.

The name Fox also seemed to fit with the AdSizzle Marketing firm she launched two years ago that now boasts two dozen clients across the restaurant, retail, automotive, and medical sectors. Then there's her recent work in the nude recreation industry, providing marketing guidance to Caliente in Land O'Lakes, Florida, along with the Sun Island Resort (Swallows), near San Diego.

"Nudists are the friendliest, most welcoming and accepting people I've ever come across," Fox says. "It seems that when people bare their bodies, they tend to bare a part of their souls as well and there's something refreshing about that to me."

Like everyone else marketing nude recreation, Fox has tried to address the issue of how to attract newcomers, especially those 45 and younger. She's done her part, personally taking 40 or so first-timers to Caliente in 2006 alone, including five of her girlfriends for New Year's Eve festivities.

"You can hold events and play music that appeal to a younger crowd, but ultimately what you need is a few young people to take the lead and bring groups of their friends," Fox says. "They'll bring their friends and then you'll start to build momentum."

If Fox makes solutions to difficult problems sound simple, well, she's had some experience in a wide range of fields.

Growing up poor, the daughter of a single mother, she vowed to use her intelligence and work ethic to create a better life. A licensed real estate broker at 19, she worked in real estate, the restaurant business, and also in television production while finishing her degree in business from the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay.

A lifelong football fan—"I know more about football than most guys," she says—Fox moved to Tampa in 1997 after a friend in the Tampa Bay Buccaneers front office offered her a job.

Two weeks after she relocated and purchased a house, her Buccaneers contact lost his job, and thus her potential gig. Suddenly looking for work, Fox stumbled upon a struggling restaurant near her home.

"The place had a lot of potential, but I could tell these weren't restaurant people running the business," she said.

She opened "Bizzy Bites" for business at the end of 1997, sold it a year later, went back to work in television as an account executive and sales manager, owned and sold a dental business with her second husband, and continued to work in real estate as the market exploded in recent years.

Late in 2004, Fox launched AdSizzle Marketing. The last thing the world needed was another ad agency, but Fox vowed to be different. The fiery red logo includes a candle for the letter "I" and looks like it could go on a bottle of hot sauce. That's only appropriate

since Fox gives out company-branded barbecue sauce as promotional items.

AdSizzle's slogan is "Why Fizzle When You Can Sizzle?"

Early in 2005, Tampa Bay commuters were bombarded with AdSizzle billboards featuring Fox and two colleagues—one male, one female—in black cocktail attire. One of the city's alternative newspapers dubbed it the "best bad billboard" of 2005, suggesting that it looked more like an advertisement for cruise ship entertainment than an ad agency.

"The ad exhibited all of the creativity and cutting-edge marketing savvy of a sandwich board sign and a hand-bell," the paper wrote.

Fox, who proudly displays the write-up in her agency portfolio, knew she had made an impression.

"If we were going to convince companies that we could aggressively market and advertise their products, I felt we had to prove we could do it for our own services," she says.

These days, AdSizzle is headed by Fox, the "marketing goddess" of the company, and "sales deevah" Darlene Robinson, a former office manager of Fox's dental office. The full-service agency has a staff of Web designers, graphic artists, and voiceover talent to provide clients with everything they'd expect.

There's also a sister company, AdSizzle Realty, Inc., that complements AdSizzle Marketing. A client recently came to Fox looking for help, thinking he needed a different ad campaign. Fox applied the first rule of real estate—location, location, location—and realized the business was a poor fit for its area. She examined his lease and provided real estate advice instead.

"You have to totally understand the businesses you work with, not just the marketing element," Fox says.

Besides the hard-to-miss billboards, Fox travels around town in a Cadillac Escalade wrapped with the equivalent of a billboard. She markets just as aggressively for her clients, especially on the Internet. She's a huge believer in using MySpace.com, the social networking site that's a favorite of the under-30 crowd, to market products and events.

"I love anything Web-based," she says. "We're not afraid to be on the cutting edge, what I call bleeding edge, and sometimes we're not a fit for really conservative companies. But clients that give us a shot tend to find we have a creative genius for coming up with things that are creative and memorable."

Fox's red-sizzle motif even carries over to her home. There's red carpeting and plenty of (red) Tampa Bay Buccaneers memorabilia. The formal living and dining area has been converted into a game room, with pool table and poker table. There are copies of *Sports Illustrated* throughout.

"People think I got the house in my divorce and haven't had time to redecorate," Fox says. "Actually, I bought it when I was single and I like it this way."

Fox, who stands 5' 9", played basketball and volleyball in high school and is a proud season ticket holder of both the Buccaneers and the Green Bay Packers. She uses the Bucs tickets to entertain clients and tries to make it home to see the Packers a couple of times a season. She's not just a Packers season-ticket holder; she's also an owner. The Packers are the NFL's only publicly-owned company, and Fox proudly displays her framed stock certificate alongside family photos and news articles about AdSizzle.

She's also an avid golfer who enjoys an occasional cigar.

"I guess you could say I have a little testosterone in me," she says.

When Fox can't make it to Caliente, she can enjoy nude recreation at home; her pool area is private and shaded from neighbors by plants and palmetto. She's still searching for a solution for one oft-voiced nudist dilemma.

"I'd love to play nude golf," she says. "I mean real nude golf, where we get a course to let us go 18 holes. It seems like there's got to be a way to make that happen."

Some AANR clubs struggle with the "singles issue." The question is how to remain accessible to single nudists, specifically single men, while maintaining a comfortable gender balance.

At least one club doesn't have to take a stance since its very existence is due to the singles issue. SingleNudist.com, which recently became AANR's newest chartered Internet-based club, caters to single nudists by serving as both a matchmaking service and an online community.

Since its launch out of San Diego in July of 2001, SingleNudist.com has been responsible for three marriages, though club owner Brian Spence says that number probably is higher since he's not always informed when vows are exchanged. Numerous other nudist relationships have formed via online, just another example of how the Internet has changed most every aspect of life.

“Our goal is to build AANR membership and to provide a resource for nudist singles to find and meet other people who believe in the same form of wholesome family nude recreation that AANR embraces,” says Spence, who also owns the San Diego-based travel

club Naturally California and serves as vice president of AANR West.

Since subscribers to SingleNudist.com must first be AANR members, the club has generated hundreds of new AANR memberships. AANR West has recognized SingleNudist.com for having either the highest number of new members or the highest membership increase by percentage in each of the last two years.

Spence, a self-taught computer guru, runs SingleNudist.com off his laptop, though he rents a server from a large Internet conglomerate in San Diego that also hosts sites belonging to Oprah Winfrey and Rush Limbaugh.

Single Nudist.com grew out of a brainstorming session between Spence and Naturally California members looking for ways to deal with the singles issue. At the time, back at the end of the first dot.com boom, many people from all walks of life had begun using the Internet to find like-minded partners.

Now, nearly six years later, the SingleNudist.com Web site continues to provide nudists the opportunity to post personal profiles and respond to others. At \$9.99 per month for men—as little as \$6.99 a month depending on length of membership—and no charge for women, it's a tremendous value compared to textile dating sites.

“We needed a way for single guys to meet nudist women outside the club setting,” Spence said. “Not only that, but we've eliminated a lot of the problems on traditional dating sites.”

The Web site has a short but firm list of rules. Only unmarried singles may join. No suggestive content may be posted.

The site features chat rooms on Monday and Thursday nights that have become quite popular. Diana Kruse and James Ferree met on SingleNudist.com on Thanksgiving Day, 2004, and were married on the beach at Caliente in Land O'Lakes, Florida, last year.

SingleNudist.com requires members to post photos—clothed or not—thus eliminating some of the false advertising seen on textile sites. Since all users must be AANR members, any misbehavior will jeopardize AANR membership.

More than 5,000 people have registered with the site over the last five years, with about 500 holding active memberships. The site has a 3-to-1 male-to-female ratio, “comparable to that of a lot of nudist clubs,” Spence said.

As one of the younger regional AANR officers, Spence, 36, always has been at the forefront of marketing to the younger generation. He was vice president of Glen Eden Sun Club while still in his 20s and launched Naturally California before his 30th birthday.

Spence felt a travel club that rented facilities for social gatherings might have better luck attracting a younger demographic, and Naturally California generally has reflected that.

Though SingleNudist.com has attracted adults of all ages, its membership is skewed more heavily toward the 50-and-older crowd, more consistent with AANR's overall membership.

“Our demographics are similar to that of AANR,” Spence said. “We do have an 18-year-old girl and a sampling of people in their 20s and 30s, but mostly it's people in their 50s and 60s.”

“You'd think the technology itself would attract younger people, but the challenge is to get that first saturation of younger people on the site. It's a chicken or the egg thing.”

Though people tend to think of nudist singles as mostly young men, the fastest-growing segment of the nudist population is singles over 50.

Some have long been single, but other AANR members are finding themselves suddenly without a partner due to death or divorce after years as part of a nudist couple. They have discretionary income, typically spending more time and money at nudist clubs than younger nudists. They are more likely to be well educated, with advanced degrees and

professional training. Not only that, but they tend to have more time to volunteer.

Spence has marketed SingleNudist.com through MySpace.com, the online social networking community that's hugely popular among the 30-and-younger crowd. He had a booth at last year's AANR Convention at DeAnza Springs, with a computer that enabled visitors to log in to the Web site.

Spence and his girlfriend, Chrissy Nixon, 30, recently appeared as guest newscasters for “Nudes in the News,” the popular Web cast on ClothesFree.com. They've placed banner ads on NetNude.com and encouraged AANR clubs to place links to SingleNudist.com on their own sites.

“We're proud to be the first Web site to be considered as an AANR club and puts us on the cutting edge of things,” Spence says. “We're excited to help bring AANR into the future; there are a lot of great concepts out there of how we can build AANR through the Web.”


Spence also is proud that SingleNudist.com strictly complies with AANR guidelines and philosophies. “Between owning two AANR-chartered clubs and working in the organization, we have AANR in our blood,” he says.







He also said that the sports clinics and other related events are part of an ongoing program to make the Willies AANR Convention the summer's social highlight. All this is in addition to a full schedule of activities, workshops, sports, and relaxing with good friends. ☺



Journey to Health

Talk With Your Mouth Full For 40 Minutes

It's that time of year again when we look in the mirror, critique our bodies, find a dozen things we don't like, and then make a bunch of carefully thought out lifestyle changes that will last ... about six minutes. OK, so maybe that's just me. Yours may last a little longer, but eventually they are all pretty much doomed to failure and I know why.

It's no big secret—behavior modification experts have known this for years. We think in perfect world terms and try to take on much too big of a lifestyle change. This leads to certain failure, and we then see ourselves as weak and incapable of change leading to a further spiraling down of our behavior. Interpretation? If going through the drive-through for a coffee and Danish on the way to work every day has been part of your morning ritual for the last 20 years, then deciding you are just not going to do it anymore will be about as successful as the next get-rich-quick scheme that you have. There is generally no easy way to do it other than hard work and a well thought out plan. In our perfect world we wouldn't drive by coffee/donut shops on every corner or give into the temptation of all the things we crave, but we do, and that's that.

Is there any hope? The answer, of course, is, of course. It just may not be the earth shattering lifestyle changes you are expecting to hear. Instead, it's the small baby steps that add up to some pretty impressive results over the long term. Every marathon race starts with that first step, and every new day starts with a sun peeking over the horizon, and every April shower begins with a single raindrop. Yuck! I'm even making myself sick here, but you get the idea. Insert your own clever life-ism if you like.

Now let's get to the single biggest preoccupation of resolutionists around the world (drum roll): weight loss. We have gained and lost the same 15 pounds so many times that success becomes relative. Just finishing the year at the same weight we started at seems like a big battle won.

The following are my 15 ways of losing that 15 pounds over the next year by taking those little baby steps, things you never even thought would burn calories. Good luck. I'll check back with you this time next year.

Each suggestion burns approximately 100 calories per day which equates to around 1 1/2 pounds per month.

February 2007

11. Do 97 push-ups or 146 sit-ups, your choice.
12. Run with scissors for 9 1/2 minutes. Must be over 18 or accompanied by an adult for this one.
13. Dance like nobody is watching for 16 minutes. If somebody is watching, dance like Michael Flatly (*Riverdance*). It will burn more calories, and you will also help someone else burn calories from laughing at you.
14. Have one less can of soda pop per day or substitute water or diet soda.
15. Walk back and forth to your boss's office for 26 minutes. This one alone will likely lead to more exercise opportunities looking for a new job once you have been let go. ☹

Books for Nudists

Clothing Optional

As a longtime member of AANR and the Cypress Cove Nudist Resort & Spa, James Arlandson knew that nudists loved to lounge around the pool reading books.

He figured they'd enjoy reading a mystery novel that takes place at a nudist resort. When he discovered that nobody had published such a book in 40 years, he wrote and self-published *Clothing Optional*, a light-hearted mystery set in a clothing-optional guest house in Key West that came out in July.

"When I first wrote the book, my agent told me that large publishing houses didn't see a market for a book involving social nudity," said Arlandson, 60, a retired businessman who moved from Minneapolis to Sarasota, Fla., 20 years ago. "I believe there is an enormous interest in the subject not only by nudists but by a large segment of the general public as well."


The novel centers around Conlan Daily, a former NFL star turned detective, who is forever searching for an idyllic Norman Rockwell existence. He thinks he's found it in Key West, at least until he's assigned to the murder case of a local guesthouse owner and discovers the "Maison de Soleil" is clothing-optional.

Other characters include Molly White, who is living undercover as the manager of the guesthouse to avoid her heavy-handed husband; and Sharon Olsson, who is enjoying a happy conservative existence in Minnesota until she finds out that her father, the murdered owner, was not spending his retirement fishing, but running a clothing-optional establishment.

Arlandson says the book's Key West nudist setting is fictional but loosely based on a restored guesthouse that he and his wife, Sena, have visited.

"I use the novel as a tool to address some of the misconceptions people have about nude recreation," Arlandson says. "Everyone is fearful or apprehensive about things they don't understand and this should help educate people."

With the line blurring between self-publishing and the mainstream New York-based book business, it's never been easier for authors to launch a book. It's still a challenge to market and promote a book via either route, but Arlandson has enjoyed some success.



He's signed books at Cypress Cove and Paradise Lakes, appeared at the Sarasota Reading Festival in November, and received some positive reviews on Amazon.com.

"It's a very competitive business," Arlandson says. "It's been an education, and there are a lot of ups and downs. You go through periods where it seems like not much is happening, but it's a lot of fun hearing from readers and meeting fellow authors. People are very supportive."

Bulletin editor Linda Berry loves murder mystery novels, and she recently read Arlandson's book. Linda said, "I loved the book. The story was intriguing, and I was fascinated by the way Jim promoted nude recreation within the story."


